A public body must post notice of every meeting at least 48 hours in advance, not including Saturdays, Sundays, and legal holidays. G.L. c. 30A, § 20(b). The notice must be printed in a legible, easily understandable format and must contain the date, time and place of the meeting, as well as a listing of topics that the chair reasonably anticipates will be discussed. The topics must be listed with sufficient specificity to reasonably advise the public of the issues to be discussed at the meeting. 940 CMR 29.03(1)(b). The topic to be listed must be sufficiently specific so a reasonable member of the public could read the topic and understand the anticipated nature of the public body's discussion.
