#### Minutes

2. Public comment – No one in attendance.
3. Communications – Email to Chief about speeding on Namskaket. Solar speed signs around town have been effective. Need more funds to add to inventory.
4. Approve Minutes of February 8, 2023 – Motion to approve made by Doug, seconded by Peter. Unanimously approved.
5. Update of DPW roadway projects:
  - Old Colony Design: review of status and next steps. – Table until Tom is present.
  - Eldredge Park Way flashing light: status – Project Completed. Chief Deering noted that cars have been going through light almost every time it's activated.
  - Old Colony Flashing Beacon: status – Table until Tom is present.
  - Other – None.
