2022 Orleans Resident Parking Schedule & Fees

2022 BEACH PARKING FEE SCHEDULE

Parking Stickers Required: **Saturday, May 28, 2022** (*weekends only*)
Saturday, June 18, 2022 (*daily*)
Last Date Parking Stickers Required: **Monday, September 5, 2022, at 4:30 PM**
Parking Sticker Required Times: **7:30 am – 4:30 pm** (*following schedule above*)

*Bicycle entry: **No Fee** - must leave bike at entry bike racks. No riding bikes in parking lots*
*Pedestrians/Drop-off: **No Fee** - Drop offs available at designated areas at entry gates*

2022 RESIDENT PARKING STICKER RATES (*all rates subject to change July 1 annually*)

Resident Parking **\$25.00** per vehicle, per season

- Resident parking stickers available to taxpayers and tenants of Orleans
- Resident Parking Stickers are available for purchase online orleansstickers.townhall247.com or by mail in only. *Current vehicle registration required.* Check, money order & credit cards accepted.
- Tenants/renters must provide three (3) valid documents proving residency annually each season. Eligible documents are listed on the sticker application.
- Sticker valid for parking at Nauset, Skaket, and the five (5) current restricted Town Landings for the entire 2022 season (see below).
- **Sticker does not guarantee parking access when parking areas are at capacity.**
- Sticker is non-refundable and non-transferrable
- Sticker expires June 30 of the following year annually

Current Town Landing Parking Restrictions

There are currently five (5) town landings/parking areas that are restricted to **resident only parking** from June 15 – September 15 annually. *You must* be a resident **and** have a current resident beach parking sticker **affixed to your vehicle** to be eligible to park in these areas. These parking areas are labeled with signage and patrolled daily by Parking Enforcement Officers. Scroll down to view the **current** restricted parking areas. Please note, these areas are subject to change annually.

IMPORTANT INFO FOR RESIDENTS

No Dogs Allowed at Nauset Beach April 1 – September 5 (this includes parking lots)

No Dogs Allowed at Skaket Beach May 27 – September 5 (this includes parking lots)

Lifeguards on Duty (9am-5pm)

Nauset – June 21 – Sept 5

Skaket – June 25 – Sept 5
