

**TOWN OF ORLEANS
PARKING RULES AND REGULATIONS**

The Select Board acting under the authority established under Chapter 89. Parking, hereby adopt the following rules and regulations governing parking and the use of Town ways, Town Landings, and Town parking lots.

ARTICLE I

Section 1. General Prohibitions

ZERO EMISSION ONLY (G.L. Ch.40, Sec. 22A) - Parking for “Zero Emission” vehicles only. Upon any Town Road or Parking Area designated to be “Zero Emission” Parking Only, including but not limited to Town EV charging station locations.

PARKING WRONG WAY ON STREET - Upon any roadway where parking is permitted, vehicles will park on side with the direction of traffic.

LESS THAN TEN (10) FEET UNOBSTRUCTED LANE – Less than 10 ft. unobstructed lane (prohibited): Upon any roadway where the parking of a vehicle will not leave a clear and unobstructed lane at least ten (10) feet wide in each travel lane for passing traffic.

ACROSS A PRIVATE ROAD OR DRIVEWAY – Any vehicle that obstructs, blocks or impedes travel to or from any private way or driveway.

WITHIN TWENTY (20) FEET OF AN INTERSECTION – Any vehicle that parks within 20 feet of an intersection so as to obstruct or impede, travel from, through or to the intersection as well as impedes lines of sight for travel or pedestrian traffic from or to the intersection.

PROHIBITED AREA – Any area designated by sign, markings, time restriction, or emergency order that prohibit the parking of vehicles.

DOUBLE PARKING – Any vehicle while parallel parked is adjacent to another vehicle(s)

SAFETY ZONE – Any vehicle parked within a designated safety zone whether for construction, public work or by emergency order.

MORE THAN ONE (1) FT FROM A CURB – Any vehicle while parking alongside a road with curbing, parks more than one foot from curb, does not apply to angled or straight-in street parking.

WITHIN A SNOW REMOVAL AREA – Any vehicle parked in a designated snow removal zone or parks to obstruct or impeded ongoing snow removal operations.

WITHIN AN INTERSECTION – Any vehicle that parks within an intersection, all parking within an intersection is prohibited.

PARKED IN A BUS STOP OR TAXI STAND – Any vehicle parked in a designated bus stop or taxi stand.

AT CONSTRUCTION SITE OBSTRUCTING TRAFFIC – Any vehicle parked within a designated or ongoing construction site that obstructs or impedes traffic.

WITHIN TEN (10) FEET OF A FIRE HYDRANT – Any vehicle parked within 10 feet of a fire hydrant.

WITHIN A FIRE LANE – Any vehicle parked completely or in part upon a designated fire lane.

HANDICAPPED PARKING – Any vehicle parked within a designated handicap parking space without proper handicap placard.

Section 2. No person shall operate, allow, or permit any vehicle registered in his name to idle or park in any of the following places set forth in Section 2 from June 15 – September 15 without a valid Resident Parking Permit/Sticker.

Cove Road Landing – Valid Resident Parking Permit/Sticker required.

Doane Road Landing and 26 Doane Road Designated Parking Area – Valid Resident Parking Permit/Sticker required.

Mill Pond Landing – Valid Resident Parking Permit/Sticker required from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

141 Portanimitic Road – Valid Resident Parking Permit/Sticker required from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Priscilla Landing – Valid Resident Parking Permit/Sticker required from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Snow Shore Landing – Valid Resident Parking Permit/Sticker required from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Tonset Landing – Valid Resident Parking Permit/Sticker required from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

17 Wildflower Lane – Valid Resident Parking Permit/Sticker required. No parking allowed from 11:00 p.m. to sunrise, year-round.

72 Tonset Road – Valid Resident Parking Permit/Sticker required. No parking allowed from 11:00 p.m. to sunrise, year-round.

Kent's Point – Valid Resident Parking Permit/Sticker required. No parking allowed from 11:00 p.m. to sunrise, year-round.

Section 3. No person shall operate, allow, or permit any vehicle registered in his name to idle or park in any of the following places set forth in Section 3 from June 15 – September 15 without a valid Resident Parking Permit/Sticker.

Mill Pond Road – Valid Resident Permit/Sticker required from 9:00 am to 5:00 p.m. on the northerly side beginning at the town landing running 400' northwesterly.

Priscilla Road – Valid Resident Permit/Sticker required from 9:00 am to 5:00 p.m. on the westerly side beginning at a point 40' from the intersection with Iyanough Road and running northerly to the intersection of Alden Road.

River Road – Valid Resident Parking Permit/Sticker required on the easterly side from opposite Lucy’s Lane to the town landing.

Snow Shore Road – Valid Resident Permit/Sticker required from 9:00 am to 5:00 p.m. on the northerly side beginning at the town landing running westerly to the corner of Seal Lane.

Tonset Road – Valid Resident Permit/Sticker required from 9:00 am to 5:00 p.m. on the northerly side beginning at the town landing running westerly to the corner of Weeset Proprietors Lane.

Section 4. No person shall operate, allow, or permit any vehicle registered in his name to idle or park in any of the following places set forth in Section 4.

Mill Pond Road – No Parking allowed anytime on the westerly side beginning at the town landing running 400’ northwesterly.

Portanimitcut Landing – No Parking anytime beginning in the northwest corner running 84’ southeasterly.

Priscilla Road – No Parking allowed anytime on the easterly side beginning at the intersection with Iyanough Road and running northerly to the town landing.

No Parking allowed anytime on the westerly side beginning at the intersection with Alden Road and running northerly to the town landing.

River Road – No parking allowed anytime on westerly side from Lucy’s Lane to the town landing.

School Road – No Trailer Parking allowed anytime on easterly side from intersection of River Road running southerly to the parking lot entrance to the Town Office Building.

No Trailer Parking allowed anytime on westerly side from intersection of River Road running 175’ southerly.

Snow Shore Road – No Parking allowed anytime on the southerly side beginning at the town landing running 222’ westerly.

Wildflower Lane - No parking allowed anytime on either side from the corner of Skaket Beach Road to the end.

Section 5. No person shall operate, allow or permit any vehicle registered in his name to idle or park in any place determined by the Police Chief to be a Prohibited Area.

Section 6. Schedule of Fines

1. The fine for the following shall be Fifty (\$50) Dollars
 - a. Zero Emission Only
 - b. Parking Wrong Way on Street
 - c. Less than Ten (10) Feet Unobstructed Lane

- d. Across a Private Road or Driveway
 - e. Within Twenty (20) Feet of an Intersection
 - f. Prohibited Area (including Temporary No Parking)
 - g. Upon a Crosswalk or Sidewalk
 - h. Double Parking
 - i. Within a Safety Zone
 - j. More than One (1) Foot from Curb
 - k. Within a Snow Removal Area
 - l. Within an Intersection
 - m. Parked in a Bus Stop or Taxi Stand
 - n. At a Construction Site Obstructing Traffic
 - o. Within Ten (10) Feet of Fire Hydrant
 - p. Within a Fire Lane
 - q. No Valid Resident Permit/Sticker
 - r. Temporary No Parking
2. The fine for the following shall be One Hundred (\$100) Dollars
- a. In a Handicapped Parking Zone
