

## ADA Coordinator

An ADA Coordinator facilitates compliance with the [Americans with Disabilities Act \(ADA\)](#) Title II regulations, and [Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 \(29 U.S.C. § 794\)](#), both of which prohibit discrimination on the basis of disability.

The ADA Coordinator:

- Coordinates the municipality's efforts to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)
- Handles disability access issues for municipal properties and events, such as processing reasonable modification requests and resolving complaints about disability-related barriers to municipal programs.
